Dear Friends,

It was with a heavy heart we watched this morning's news to see the evil and unprovoked attack on Ukraine by President Putin and his forces.

As Christians, we are called to be peacemakers and peacekeepers, it is in this calling I invite the people of Darlington & Teesdale Methodist Circuit to continue in their earnest prayer for peace.

The Church of England has called for their people to make this Sunday a "day for prayer for Ukraine, Russia and for peace." Pope Francis has called for Ash Wednesday to be "a day of prayer and fasting for peace".

Whilst I understand that not all people can safely fast due to health reasons, we can all safely pray and suggest that as a Circuit we pray together and fast if able, for this moment to allow the Holy Spirit to move in the hearts of all involved and bring dialogue and lasting peace.
